Uncle, how do we make the Pū 'ohe?

First, we sand the Pū 'ohe going with the grain.

We use the 60-grit sandpaper to smooth the rough edges.





Uncle uses a small knife to make a dime sized hole on the closed end.

This is where our lips go!



How do we play the Pū 'ohe, Uncle?

Make a yucky face with your lips together and a small opening. Now blow and feel your cheeks fill up.

I got it!





Uncle, when do we use the Pū 'ohe?

We use the Pū 'ohe to get people's attention like when the Hōkūle'a is arriving. We blow the Pū 'ohe towards the four corners.

East= Hikina

South= Hema

West= Komohana

North= 'Ākau
